

Lacq Douglas Stain

Lacq Douglas Stain is a durable and high-quality protective agent especially suitable for douglas and larch wood. Douglas Stain protects your wood against the weather, giving the wood its natural appearance for a long time retains. Douglas Beits is water-based and built from vegetable components. Thanks to the unique composition, Douglas Beits builds on the inside from layer thickness on. This moisture-regulating layer remains flexible so that it is even in stressful weather conditions do not flake or crack and retain the color.

Applicable to outdoor wood:

- Garden house
- Fence
- Veranda
- Garden furniture
- Rabbet parts
- Other outdoor wood types

Preparation:

- Bring Douglas Stain to room temperature.
- Stir Douglas Stain well from the bottom.
- Use a flat brush or roller suitable for water-based paint.
- Process between 9 °C and 25 °C.

Pay attention! Always put on a sample first to see if you get the desired finish. This can differ per wood type.

Processing on untreated wood:

Pretreatment:

- 1. First graying grayed wood with Lacq Turbogel.
- 2. Always clean and degrease the wood before treatment with Douglas Stain.
- 3. Use Fluxaf Pro-Clean or Fluxaf Powerclean for this. You only need to sand if one smooth result is desired.

Finish:

For optimal protection, we recommended applying 2 layers of Douglas Stain. Work in the longitudinal direction of the wood grain.

Processing on existing paint or stain layers:

Pretreatment:

- 1. Remove existing paint or stain layers by biting off with Fluxaf, sanding or blow-drying.
- 2. Cleaning and degreasing with Fluxaf Pro-clean or Powerclean.
- 3. Carefully sand away weathered and / or defective parts and remove any wood rot.
- 4. Repair damage to the wood with a suitable agent.

Finish:

For optimal protection, we recommended applying 2 layers of Douglas Stain. Work in the longitudinal direction of the wood grain.

Coverage:

About 16 m² per liter.

Pay attention! Efficiency always depends on the structure, suction of the wood, the thickness of the layer, the tools used and the conditions of application.

Drying time:

Drying times depend on the applied layer and the ambient temperature. Optimal conditions are 20 $^{\circ}$ C.

Dust dry: approx. 1 hour. Recoatable after: approx. 6 hours.

Cleaning:

Clean tools with water and seal airtight and turn it over to fill the rim for a good seal.

Available quantities:

0,75L, 2,5L &, 20L.

Available colors:

Natural, Aged Grey & Douglas Brown.

Pay attention! The type of wood and the number of layers applied can influence the color result. We therefore recommend that you always set up a test piece first, so that you can get the result judge.

Shelf life:

In unopened tightly closed packaging, stored dry at a temperature between 3 ° C. and at 25 ° C, the product properties are guaranteed for approximately 2 years. Pour half-full cans into one smaller tin helps prevent skin formation and drying. Store frost-free!

Pay attention! Duration of the wood protection depends on the quality of the wood, correct pretreatment, execution of the paintwork, maintenance and intensity of load.
