Application On Untreated Wood:

- 1. The surface must be clean, dry and sound. Remove dirt, dust, mould, algae and moss growth and loose parts. Sanding is not necessary, only when a smooth result is desired.
- 2. First clean greyed wood with Lacq Wood Degreaser.
- 3. Clean with Fluxaf Pro-Clean.
- 4. Stir the contents thoroughly.
- 5. Use a flat brush, roller, or airless paint sprayer. Apply in the longitudinal direction of the wood grain for a good finish.
- 6. Apply first coat.
- 7. The second coat can only be applied after complete drying.
- 8. We recommend applying 3 coats for optimal protection.

Duration of wood protection depends on the quality of the wood, correct pre-treatment, execution of painting, maintenance, and intensity of load. Always do a test area first to see if you get the desired finish and this will vary on different wood.

Surface Maintenance:

To make best use of the product, the surface should be cleaned and maintained annually. The surface can be cleaned by gently wiping it. Use a damp cleaning cloth or soft sponge for this purpose. Rough brushing and strong detergents should be avoided.

Tools

Flat brush or roller suitable for solvent-based paint.

Coverage:

Approximately 12 m² per litre.

Coverage always depends on the structure, porosity of the wood, layer thickness, the tools used and application conditions.

Dust-dry: Approx. 5-6 hours

Paintable: Approx. 16 hours (depending on temperature).

Clean tools with white spirit.

750 ml.

Finish:

Silk gloss.

Available as standard in Natural, Impregnated, Brown & Black.

Please note! The type of wood and the number of coats applied may influence the colour result. We therefore recommend always putting on a test area first to assess the result.

Shelf Life:

Close airtight after use and turn over briefly to fill the rim for a good seal. Store 2 years in original unopened packaging, frost-free, in a dry place (temperature between 5°C and 35°C).
